What is Happening Now to DOT Compliance?

The top priorities of the Department of Transportation is to keep the traveling public safe and secure, increase their mobility, and have our transportation system contribute to the nation's economic growth. In this one hour session, Mr. Byers will discuss the new definition of a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) in the state of Colorado by the DOT. He will review how the new definition is affecting the transportation industry and carriers specifically. In December 2015, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) published

the final electronic logging device rule or better known as the ELD mandate. Ryan will discuss the ELD mandate in-depth and provide an opportunity for questions and answers.

Ryan Byers, owner of Front Range Compliance Services, is a former Colorado State Patrol Trooper who was the rank of Technician in the Motor Carrier Safety Section. During Ryan's time with the Colorado State Patrol he became a Master Instructor for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and was the DOT Training Coordinator for the State of Colorado.
